Paddle Steamer "Whippingham"

"Whippingham" was built in 1930 in the Fairfield Shipyard, Govan, Scotland for use on the Southern Railway's Isle of Wight service from Portsmouth.

The ship was also used for 'cruises' around the Solent and to Bournemouth. During the War it was involved in the Dunkirk evacuation, rescuing 2700 soldiers, and the Normandy landings.

In 1962 it was withdrawn from service and broken up in Antwerp the following year.
